

### **Eligibility:**

Applicant must be a high school senior that is an enrolled Union County 4-H member.

Applicant must be a 4-H member in good standing for at least three years in ninth through twelfth grade.

#### **Instructions:**

Only complete application packets will be considered for review.

All application packets must be submitted to the OSU Extension, Union County Office by 5:00 pm on March 1.

Since this will be a blind review, **please avoid identifying the applicant by name** as much as possible.

### **Application packet includes:**

1.	4-H essay (minimum of 350 words/maximum 3 pages) Essay ideas: How 4-H has focused my future How 4-H has affected me How I plan to continue to benefit my community Personal growth through 4-H 4-H activities involved in	30 pt
2.	Two letters of recommendation, attached to application. 10 point each	20 pt
3.	High school transcript 2.0 GPA & above - 10 pt Below 2.0 - 5 pt	10 pt
4.	Completed application questionnaire 6 points each section 1. Outstanding 4-H event (A & B) 2. Contribution to 4-H (C) 3. Obstacles overcome (D) 4. Career goals, Area of planned study (E & F) 5. Community involvement, Leadership (G & H)	30 pt
5.	Presentation of Application Portfolio (Neatness, organized, penmanship, order of contents, etc)	10 pt

#### **Scholarship Criteria:**

- contribution to 4-H program (based on essay and application questionnaire)
- leadership and community involvement
- academic records and school involvement

The scholarships in the amount of \$800.00 will be awarded directly to the recipient at their awards/graduation ceremony.

Scholarship application deadline is March 1.

Scholarship to be used toward expenses for schooling of your choice.

#### **Selection Process:**

Winning applicants will be chosen by a 2-3 person scholarship committee by blind review. Scholarship committee is appointed by the Union County Association Executive Council and can consist of 4-H Leader(s) and/or community member(s) that have no knowledge of any scholarship applicants. In addition to the scholarship committee, one executive council member will act as liaison in a non voting capacity.

Application review and scholarship selection committee will meet jointly after application deadline and before graduation.
