



CLACKAMAS COUNTY 4-H RECORD OF ANIMAL LEASE

- 1) All animals exhibited in 4-H must have been carried as a 4-H project by the exhibitor since June 1 of current year.
- 2) This form must be turned in to the 4-H office no later than June 1st to be given to the Clackamas County 4-H Livestock Advisory Committee for approval, and to be on file at the County Extension Office.
- 3) Project animals may be shown only by the 4-H member between the dates of June 1 and the close of State Fair.
- 4) Picture of leased animal must be attached to application.
- 5) Members may not show leased animals in project areas where they own animals.
- 6) Members may show only one leased animal in a project where they do not have their own animals. (A female animal with nursing offspring counts as one animal. Upon weaning, a single animal must be designated as the project animal.)
- 7) **THIS IS NOT A LEASE AGREEMENT.** The owner and member should complete a separate contract detailing the lease conditions.
