- Applicant must plan to attend a vocational-technical school, community college, four-year college or university beginning in the fall immediately following graduation from high school

- Complete Application Form, including all required signatures.
- One essay (typed, single spaced, 1-inch margins, 12 point font, 1 page maximum) that explains the benefits of participating in 4-H and how 4-H has impacted your future goals/plans.
- A letter of reference from your 4-H leader.
- A copy of your 4-H records.
- A copy of your high school transcripts (an unofficial copy is ok)
