All classes are state qualifying for Intermediates and Senior members

- A 4-H member may enter one individual and one team presentation. Only one presentation can qualify for State Fair.
- A team consists of two members (ie. Jr., Int., or Sr. Division). If from different divisions, they will be judged at the higher division level.
- Topic of presentation may be anything the member wants to share with others.
- K-3 youth can present alone or with the guidance of an older youth. The older youth would be a helper and confidence builder rather than a presenter.
- The use of notes is permitted. However, the excessive use of notes may be counted against the contestant at the judge's discretion.
- 4-H members must furnish all supplies and equipment required except those we've listed on the registration form.
- Premiums will be awarded after county fair.
- State Fair selections, champions, and special awards will be based on these contest results.
- Contestants should cite their major references at the conclusion of their presentation.

Presentations include:

- Demonstration: Shows how something is done (action). Cloverbuds 5 min. or less, Juniors 3 10 min., Int/Sr's 10-15 min.
- Illustrated Talk: Share info using visuals (posters, PowerPoint, etc)
 Cloverbuds 5 min. or less, Juniors 3 10 min., Sr/Int's 10 15 min.
- Public Speech: Informative or persuasive, no visuals used. Cloverbuds
 1 5 min., Juniors 3 8 min., Int/Sr's 7 -10 min.
- Impromptu Speech: Deliver speech w/no prior prep, no visuals. Draw a topic. Cloverbuds & Juniors up to 3 min., Int/Sr's 3 – 5 min

3 steps to "Showing and Telling"

1. Introduction

Tell what you're going to do Tell why you chose your topic

2. Body

Tell about and show how to make or do something step-by-step

3. Conclusion

Give a short summary
Ask if anybody has a question
