- Registration \$15 per child DUE BY Friday, May 10, 2019
- ❖ We are waiving the cleaning deposit this year but you <u>MUST</u> check out with Horse Superintendents (Laura Kalhar or Kevin Hansen)
- Camping \$5 per night per camper or tent (Checks only for camping made payable to Columbia County Fair)
 - o Camping will be on "Main Street" not in the field
- Horse trailer parking will be north of the arena (same as at county fair)
- Refund Policy: 100% on or before May 10. No refunds after May 10 or for No Shows.

- ABSOLUTELY NO DRIVING ALLOWED ON GROUNDS AFTER 8 AM (Except market animals that are brought to be weighed in)
- No Parking on Main Street or around Flagpole

 - o Saturday, 7 8 am
 - o Sunday, 7-8 am
- Use Livestock Gate
- Obey Parking Signs
- No Stallions or Wet Mares
- Rained out portions of Youth Fair will not be rescheduled or refunded.
- Horses must be in their stalls by 8 am on Saturday.
- No horse trailers will be allowed to enter or leave between the hours of 8 am and end of show on Saturday & Sunday.
- If you feel you need to leave, please leave your horse trailer outside the gate and lead your horse out.
- Horse Participants must follow all 4-H Horse Rules.

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
