



4-H PIG SCRAMBLE RULES Coos County Fair



Due: July 15

- Coos County 4-H members who have completed grades 4-7 are eligible to apply. You do not need to be in an animal science project.
- Thirty five total applicants will be accepted. A list of applicants/contestants will be posted near the livestock show ring on Wednesday and Thursday of fair.
- Contestants who catch a pig have the option to keep the pig and raise it. Pigs that you keep, may not be sold.
- Contestants who choose to keep a pig and raise it, are required to keep feed and health records for the animal and submit those to the Extension office by Oct. 31. The pigs may be butchered after Oct. 31.
- You may compete in the contest each year until you successfully catch a pig. Once you catch a pig, you are no longer eligible for future pig scramble contests.
- The Coos County Fair Board, 4-H, or others connected with the contest are not responsible for any accidents or injuries connected with this contest.
- No application will be considered that is not properly completed. Applications must be signed by a parent or guardian and your 4-H leader.
- Submit all applications to the Coos County OSU Extension Office, 631 Alder St, Myrtle Point, OR 97458.
- The scramble will take place Friday night during the rodeo break, approximately 8 pm.
- Details of the contest will be carefully explained at a contestant meeting in the livestock show ring just before starting time.
