 - c. Roosters and Cockerels must be in a cage by themselves. 1 per cage
 - d. Example of a members chicken entries: **4 Bantams – Need 3 cages; 2 Reg. Size Chickens – Need 1 cage; 10 Meat Birds – Need 3 cages**
 - e. You do not need to list the breed or sex of your birds
 - f. **All birds must be banded**
