Leaf Stamping

- 1. Lay leaf down on newspaper or paper plate
- 2. Paint leaf with your choice of color
- 3. Press painted side of leaf onto the surface you would like painted (could be paper, pumpkin, jar, etc.) and rub in the pain to the surface
- 4. Lift the leaf, and you've made your stamp! See Example

Leaf Shading

- 1. Place leaf on your table and place piece of paper on top of the leaf
- 2. Rub crayon on the area of the paper on top of the leaf
- 3. Continue to do this with a variety of leaves until you fill your paper with leaf shadings
- 4. Now you have a page of leaves! See example.

<u> Hot Apple Orange Cider</u>

Ingredients

64 fluid ounces 100% apple juice (8 cups)

32 fluid ounces water (4 cups)

2 oranges

12 whole cloves

2 allspice peppercorns

6 cinnamon sticks

Directions

- In a 4 quart stock pot, add apple juice, water, oranges (cut in half) and all the spices.
- 2. Bring to a boil and simmer for 2 hours.
- 3. Serve hot and enjoy!
- 4. Refrigerate leftovers within 2 hours.
