Roles of a County 4-H Ambassador

- Represent 4-H to the public.
- Be a role model to all 4-H members.
- Abide by the 4-H Code of Conduct.
- Promote 4-H to potential members and volunteers make families and youth more aware of 4-H and the benefits it offers.
- Demonstrate the impact 4-H has on the lives of young people and the community.
- Promote 4-H to potential donors and give them opportunities to support the program.
- Be a resource to county and state 4-H staff.

Responsibilities of an Ambassador

- Submit items for posting on the county 4-H Facebook page through OSU Extension Service Staff.
- Work at one or more county events (Fair, Awards & Recognition Program, Learn By Doing 4-H Event, etc.).
- Participate in fundraisers for countywide events and special ambassador fundraisers, if applicable.
- Help at Fair Cleanup Day by being there and by recruiting help
- Help at the annual awards and recognition night

- Help with a countywide community service project.
- Attend a 4-H Association meeting.
- Attend a Wheeler County Fair Board Meeting.
- Visit schools to talk about the ambassador program and 4-H in general.
- Help county staff with trainings (new leader training, record book training, parliamentary procedure training, etc.), potentially.
- Write an article for the local newspaper.
- Use social media during county events.
- Write an article for the extension newsletter.
