

Job Description for the Jackson County Youth Livestock Ambassadors

Purpose:

The purpose of the Youth Livestock Ambassadors is to:

- serve as an ambassador for the 4-H/FFA auction program to the community.
- assist the auction committee in improving the quality of the Jackson County livestock auctions.
- serve in a leadership role in the beef, sheep, and swine projects before & during the fairs.

Expectations of Committee Members:

5 - 10 youth are needed who have demonstrated:

- a willingness and ability to commit time and energy to tasks.
- an ability to work cooperatively with others.
- the capacity to make decisions, take charge, and follow-through with limited supervision.
- public speaking skills.

Time Commitment:

Youth are asked to serve a one-year term.

Who can Apply:

Jackson County 4-H or FFA members in the 11th or 12th grade may apply.

How to Apply:

- Complete and turn in a hard copy of your application to the 4-H Extension Office no later than 4:30 pm on Friday, January 11, 2019. Office is located at 569 Hanley Road, Central Point.
- Sign-up for a mandatory interview when you turn in your application.
- Interviews will be held on Tuesday, January 15, 2019 at the 4-H Extension Office beginning at 4 pm. Time slots will be first come, first serve.
