

**Marie Madison Horticulture Scholarship of the Benton County Master Gardener Association
Application Instructions**

About this Scholarship

The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage and enhance the academic study of horticulture, botany, and plant science. It is a non-renewable \$1,000 scholarship. More than one scholarship may be awarded, depending upon available funds.

Eligibility: The scholarship is open to any college student who:

- is a matriculated, registered student at Linn-Benton Community College or Oregon State University,
- has declared a major in botany, horticulture, and/or plant science,
- has successfully completed at least 24 college credits, and
- has demonstrated interest and involvement in activities that promote sustainable gardening through community service and/or public education.

**BCMGA Board members, Scholarship Committee members, and their family members are not eligible to apply.*

Application Elements

1. Application Form:

Applicants must complete and submit the application form.

2. Written Statement:

The applicant shall provide a written statement describing the applicant's involvement in an academic project or community activity demonstrating the applicant's interest in the fields of horticulture, botany, and/or plant science.

The written statement should be no more than one (1) page in length and no more than 500 words. The statement must be presented on 8½ x 11 inch paper using a 10- or 12-point font size and one-inch margins. The applicants should use "Written Statement" as the title. The applicant's name should appear in the top, right-hand corner.

The applicant also has the option to submit one (1) page of captioned photographs of the project or activity being described. No people should appear in the photographs. Photographs are optional and will not be returned.

3. Letters of Recommendation:

One (1) letter of recommendation is required which is from an instructor of a horticulture or plant science course the applicant has attended or from a supervisor if the work is in the field of plant science or horticulture. The reference must be mailed directly and postmarked by the application deadline. Family members are not eligible as references.

4. College Transcript:

The applicant shall provide a copy of college transcripts, including winter term grades, and must sign the following declaration: *I certify that all of the information furnished on this form and submitted to the committee is true and complete and correct to the best of my knowledge. I understand that such information is confidential and subject to verification by the Marie Madison Scholarship Committee.*

Extended Deadline:

All application materials described above must be mailed to The Marie Madison Scholarship Committee at the address listed below and postmarked by **April 15, 2019**.

Submitting the Application:

Application materials may be sent by mail or delivered by hand and may not be submitted electronically. However, letters of recommendation must be sent directly by the person providing the reference.

Determination:

Selection of the scholarship recipient will be based on the *application, written statement, community involvement, transcripts, letters of recommendation, and future plans*. Eligibility is not based on need.

No family members of Scholarship Committee members or the Benton County Master Gardener™ Association Board of Directors (voting or non-voting) shall be eligible for consideration of this scholarship.
