The Hopkins Demonstration Forest in partnership with Oregon State University, Clackamas County Extension Service is hosting a FREE day in the woods for homeschool groups, support networks, or youth organizations. All grade levels (single or blended) are welcome however activities are targeted for grades 2-12.

The self-guided day will include a variety of grade appropriate activity and educational stations spread across the 140-acre forest. Some stations will have staffed educator lead activities while others will be participant lead. All supplies will be provided at each station or to participants to checkout for the day.

Group check-in and equipment handout begins at 8:30am and closes at 11:30am with forest programs concluding at 1:30pm. Final checkout/equipment return no later than 2:00pm.
