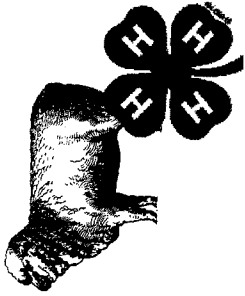

Fleece must be free from second cuts and tags, dry, properly rolled and in a clear plastic bag. This wool tag should be completely filled out and visible inside the bag.



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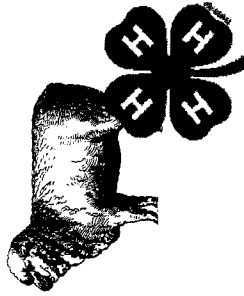
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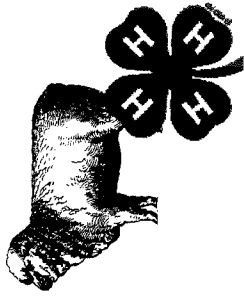
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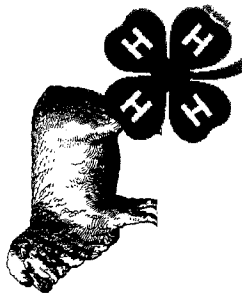
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Suggestions for Care of Show Fleeces:

1. Shear when dry; avoid second cuts; keep fleece in one piece.
2. Lay out flat on clean floor, flesh side down.
3. Remove tags, burs, and other foreign material.
4. Fold sides and neck in and fold from rear.
5. Weigh
6. Place in clean clear plastic bag.
7. Store in clean, dry place free from insects and rodents.
8. Don't forget to include this wool tag.
9. Wool is scored on the following criteria:
Weight (25), Strength (20), Length (15), Character (10),
Uniformity (10), Purity (10), Preparation (10)
