

Coos Grange Scholarship for the Coos County 4-H Program

Due: May 15

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000

Purpose:

- To provide incentive for further education to a Coos County 4-H member.
- To recognize meritorious work and achievement in 4-H.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a resident of Coos, Curry or Western Douglas County
- Applicant must currently be a senior in high school
- Applicant must be currently enrolled in the 4-H
- Applicant must have been a 4-H member for at least 3 years, including the current year
- Applicant must plan to attend a vocational-technical school, community college, four-year college or university beginning in the fall immediately following graduation from high school
- Applicant must plan to major in natural resources (agriculture, forestry, fisheries, etc.)
- Financial need is important, but may not be the deciding factor.

Instructions:

- Complete Application Form, including all required signatures.
- One essay (typed, single spaced, 1-inch margins, 12 point font, 1 page maximum) that explains your future goals/plans.
- A letter of reference from your 4-H leader.
- A copy of your 4-H records.
- A copy of your high school transcripts (an unofficial copy is ok)
