Marketing Auction Animals: An Effort of the CYAC and You

Producing a top quality product, whether it is an animal, apple pie or a new piece of software takes time and initiative. Getting others interested in the product also takes time and initiative. Now is the time to put your energies toward marketing your auction animal.

There are several ways of making this happen:

- * Let others do the job for you. Rely on their expertise and experience.
- Work in a partnership with others who are supporting your project.
- * Create a marketing plan and put it into action.

All of these techniques are in use in the 4-H/FFA Auction Animal program. The Coos Youth Auction Committee has developed a reputable program that has been very successful in providing buyers and setting guidelines for producing quality meat products. Individual committee members have promoted the sale and encouraged community support.

4-H and FFA members have presented information about the program to potential buyers at various community meetings. Youth participants have also designed letters and invitations to send to individuals and businesses.

OSU Extension has worked with youth and the Coos Youth Auction Committee to ensure advertising and promotional pieces are prepared and distributed. All of these techniques have been successful in providing an animal auction that secures premium prices for quality meat animals.
