in-person at SOREC for a primer on identifying a number of
sedimentary, metamorphic, and igneous rocks. Maximum 25
participants; \$15 per person.

October 24 (9:30 AM-5:00 PM) **Field trip.** We will meet at SOREC
and travel by auto caravan to explore three different metamorphic
terranes brought into juxtaposition by major faults. Exposures reveal
low- to high-temperature metamorphic rocks, as well as sedimentary
and plutonic rocks, all of which have been intensely folded, spindled,
and manipulated by Mother Nature as she created the Klamath
Mountains. Maximum 20 participants; \$70 per person.
