All classes will be held at the OSU Extension Office, 1134 SE Douglas Ave. in the auditorium. Our 4-H Extension program is in the modified operations phase for onsite and in-person programming, with a low-density, mixed modality approach and modifications made as needed for public health and safety. Groups are limited to 10 or few participants/session (plus adequate number of staff) to reduce potential exposure to COVID-19.

Closer to the event, registered participants will receive an e-mail confirmation with specific directions for staggered drop off and pick up times, regulations regarding physical distancing and the best practices for staying healthy. If participants do not have access to appropriate PPE, it will be provided.

Classes may have to be cancelled or rescheduled due to modified operations based on COVID-19 with very short notice. All notifications will be made by e-mail to participants parent or guardian.
