

FALL 2019 MASTER WOODLAND MANAGER TRAINING

The Master Woodland Manager (MWM) program will help you gain in-depth skills for tending your forest, provide you with opportunities to share your passion for stewardship with others, while learning from topic experts from across the state. **As this is an advanced program, prior woodland management experience and/or education (e.g. participation at an Introductory Forest Management course or Tree School) is recommended.**

The Master Woodland Manager training is offered by OSU FNR Extension, in collaboration with local partners and with support from Oregon Forest Resources Institute (OFRI). This support allows us to offer the training at a low cost to participants (\$100). **In return, graduates commit to give an equivalent number of class hours (approximately 60) in volunteer service.**



ABOUT THIS TRAINING

- Classes held from 9am – 4pm (may be adjusted for some classes)
- Cost: \$100 per person
- Over 60 hours of mostly field-based instruction
- Visit a variety of forest properties & see diverse management strategies in Douglas County
- MWM is offered every 5 - 8 years & seats are limited
