Course Structure

- Nine self-paced online lessons (one new lesson each week)
- Three instructor-led weeknight virtual classes featuring resource experts



Expectations

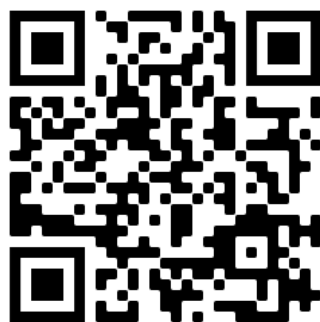
- Plan to spend two hours per week on each self-paced online lesson and related activities.
