4-H HORSE PRE-FAIR RULES

MEMBER SECTION – READ AND SIGN

1. Advancements must have been completed and turned in to the Extension Office by May 22, 2019.
2. Copies of Horse Declaration forms and lease agreements, if you are leasing, must have been turned into the Extension Office by April 15, 2019.
3. All horses shown must be project horses.
4. Classes will be conducted according to 4-H rules and policies as set forth in the PNW 4-H Horse Contest Guide, horse project materials, and Benton County 4-H Horse Contest Outline.
5. Boots must be worn in all classes.
6. Approved helmets must be worn in all classes except Showmanship and Dummy Roping from the Ground.
7. There will be only a one-minute gate hold on classes.
8. If you do In-hand Trail, you cannot enter the same horse in the Trail class.
9. Ranch Horse Roping consists of three levels: **1. Dummy roping from ground; 2. Dummy roping from horse; and 3. Live cow roping.** Juniors and Horseless members may only compete in dummy roping from ground. Intermediates may compete in dummy roping from ground or dummy roping from horse. Seniors may compete in any of the three levels.
10. Clean up all manure and garbage around your trailer before you leave.
11. You must attend the Judges meeting on every day you show. If you miss the Judges meeting or you do not sign in, you will not show that day.
12. If any leader of Benton County 4-H sees a disapproving action on the grounds, he/she has authority and responsibility to correct the situation.
13. Any concerns or variances should be taken up with the fair superintendents or the County Agent.
