Beef weigh In took place Saturday February 10, 2024. Thank you to all who volunteered their time to make this happen for 4-H and FFA youth.

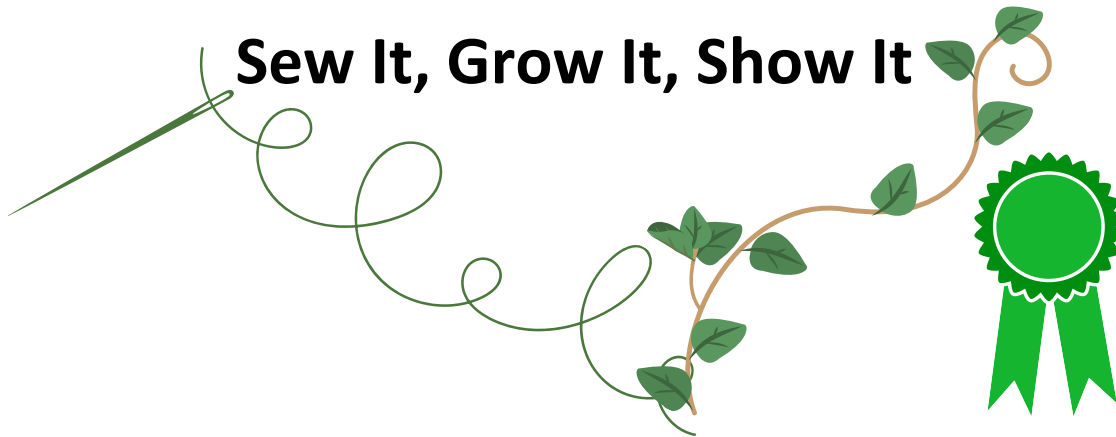
2025 Beef Weight Changes

Once you have been fully enrolled, you'll receive an e-mail with instructions and a code to be able to access your club's roster through your 4-H online account.

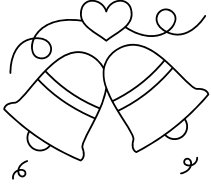
Remember: You are not in compliance and will not be covered by insurance if you are not enrolled.

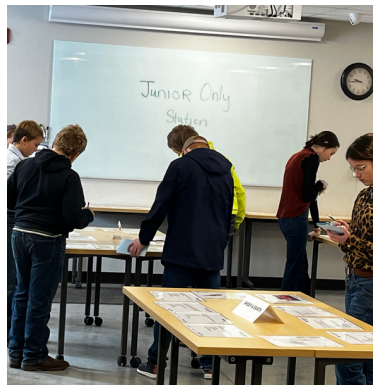
