- MUST BE AN INTERMEDIATE OR SENIOR MEMBER (2021-22)
- MUST COMPETE IN ALL 6 RANCH HORSE EVENTS, AND USE THE SAME HORSE IN THE HORSE EVENTS
- MEMBERS MUST AVERAGE AN 80 IN THEIR 5 BEST EVENTS (*SEE PAGE 2 OF THE RANCH HORSE CONTEST GUIDE*)

General Rules

Follow the current *Oregon 4-H Ranch Horse Contest Guide*.

Dogs are NOT allowed in horse occupied areas.

Horses may not be left over night tied to a trailer-they must be kept in a stall

Exhibitor fees will be used to cover facilities, judges, and other necessities

Seniors will rope cattle break away hondas required; intermediates will rope a simulator

You will be registered in all 6 (six) Ranch Horse Events, including:

- Ranchmanship (showmanship)
- Ranch Horse Pattern
- Ranch Horse Skills
- Cow Working
- Roping
- Ranch Horse Trail

Schedule of Events ~ October 1, 2022

Members should come prepared to pay attention, there will be at least 3 events going on at the same time and participants will be expected to move from one to the next on their own.

In the Morning

8:30 AM Meeting with the judges

9:00 AM Ranch Horse Showmanship (All Ages)

10:00 AM Cow Working (SR) & Ranch Horse Trail Begin (INT)
followed by the "other" age group

10:30 AM Ranch Horse Skills Begins (ALL Ages)

In the Afternoon

1:00 PM Roping (INT) & Ranch Horse Pattern Begin (SR)
followed by the "other" age group

4:00 PM Awards Presentation

This is a very *tentative schedule*; exact schedule will depend on the number of participants.

Where to go when I arrive?

The event is at the Deschutes County Fairgrounds, (3800 SW Airport Way, Redmond, OR 97756) Sagebrush Arena and horses will be stalled in the horse barn, camping outside the RV park will be in front of (west) of the horse barn on the grass. Enter the fairgrounds from either entrance and turn left as soon as possible, follow the paved road around past a ropes course on your left, then a large cyclone fence on your right, then a guard shack on your left, through the gate – first building on your right is the horse barn – Sagebrush arena is the covered arena directly south when you drive in.
