Two (2) medals per category may be awarded annually if there is sufficient merit amongst nominees.

***To be eligible for these awards, members must meet the following requirements:***

1. County Medal recipients must be an Intermediate or Senior; Jr Boy/Girl must be a Junior.
2. Members may receive only one project medal per year; members may only receive the Jr Boy/Girl award once in their 4-H career. They may be awarded Livestock and Non-Livestock.
3. If merited by outstanding accomplishment, members may receive the same medal once as an Intermediate and once as a Senior.

The 4-H leader nominates a member by filling out the County Medal & Outstanding Jr Boy/Girl Application. Additional applications are available in the Extension Office or online. Please return this form to the Extension Office by the August All County 4-H Meeting.
