High School Senior Scholarship

Animal Leases and Horse Declaration

Animal Science Projects (All species) that are not owned by the 4-H Member or the 4-H Members family with the intent for the animal to be shown at the County Fair need to have a Lease on file with the 4-H Office by April 5th, 2024 by 5 pm.

Horse 4-H Members are required to complete the Horse Declaration by April 5th. This form must be completed by all Tillamook County 4-H Members who wish to participate in any horse related 4-H Activity, Event, Contest, or Exhibition no matter if the animal is leased, owned, or shared. Please read all instruction as to what is needed to submit the declaration. This form can be collected digitally or by paper upon request of the OSU Extension Office 4-H Staff.
