

Morrow Bros. Inc., Jefferson County 4-H and FFA Scholarship

College/Technical School Scholarship Jefferson County

***** (Must be attending Oregon State University to apply for this scholarship) *****

Due: April 15, 2026

Purpose:

Morrow Bros. Inc. has established this scholarship to provide incentive for furthering education of the youth of Jefferson County. The Morrow brothers wish to encourage youth participation in 4-H clubs and FFA, and to recognize the work and achievements of 4-H and FFA members.

Eligibility:

Any Jefferson County resident who has had a total of one year of experience in a recognized 4-H club or FFA organization is eligible. It is possible for applicants to combine both their 4-H and FFA experience to gain the one-year total. This scholarship only applies to applicants who will be attending Oregon State University.

Qualified students must meet at least two of the following criteria:

- Meet the current admission requirements of Oregon State University
- Evidence of involvement in community service activities
- Graduation from a Jefferson County High School

Qualified students are eligible for the Morrow Bros. Inc., Jefferson County 4-H and FFA Scholarship, regardless of additional scholarship awards received or assigned.

Application Requirements:

First time applicants:

1. Completion of Financial Need Form from Jefferson Co. Extension office.
2. 500-word 12pt. font essay. Essay should identify educational goals and objectives, and long-term personal goals of the scholarship applicant.
3. Copy of high school transcript for high school seniors and of school grades/transcript for applicants who have already received a high school diploma.
4. Three letters. For a high school senior, letters are to be from a high school teacher, 4-H/FFA leader and third letter chosen by applicant. For 4-H/FFA alumni who have graduated from high school, all three letters need to be current and from individuals of their choice. Letters are to be sent directly to OSU Jefferson County Extension, c/o 4-H Scholarship Committee, 850 NW Dogwood Lane, Madras, Oregon 97741.

Renewal applicants:

1. Letter requesting consideration for renewal of the scholarship.
2. 500-word 12pt. font essay with the applicant's review of his or her progress in meeting the goals described the previous year and/or how the applicant's goals have changed, and any new goals. (The donors intend this essay to encourage self-analysis and goal setting by the applicant, and not for the Scholarship Committee to evaluate the applicant on achievement of previous goals.) If the applicant does not demonstrate thoughtful analysis, the applicant should be encouraged to give the process more attention.
3. Completion of Financial Need Form.
4. Copy of grades/transcripts of current year
5. Three letters of reference, which are current, and from individuals of their choice. Letters are to be sent directly to OSU Jefferson County Extension, c/o 4-H Scholarship Committee, 850 NW Dogwood Lane, Madras, Oregon
6. **Award:** 4-H and FFA participants are eligible for this award. It is possible to receive the Morrow Bros. Inc., Jefferson County 4-H and FFA Scholarship during each year of study, providing the individual reapplies each year and is making satisfactory progress toward completion of their program.
