

Tick Talk: Common Ticks in the Rogue Valley



Jim Clover is a retired public-health biologist with a specialty in vector-borne disease and control. His emphasis on ticks developed during 25 years with California Department of Health Services and subsequent years as a consultant in Oregon and in California, where he developed and coordinated a statewide Lyme-disease monitoring program and co-authored numerous published studies on ticks and other vectors.

This presentation will cover the what, where, why, when, and how of ticks. We will learn about tick life cycles, preferred habitats, and potential tick-borne diseases common to Southwest Oregon.

Proper tick removal and mitigation strategies to avoid infestations will be reviewed.
