What are my options for buying or supporting?

1. **Live Auction Event** – bid real time in person
2. **Add-On** – contribute outside of the auction event

Live Auction Event

- **I'm a new bidder – how do I participate?** You can pre-register by going to <https://forms.gle/RiNAXumo93ccVk5VA> or you can arrive early the day of the sale to sign up for a bidder's number. You'll need a bidder's number to bid on and purchase animals.
- **Do I pay for my purchases at the auction?** No – we will invoice you after the sale. Please pay as soon as possible after receiving your invoice, because we cannot pay the 4-H & FFA members until we receive the funds.

Add-On

- **What is an Add-On?** An Add-On is a direct contribution made to a specific youth in the auction. Add-Ons can also be generic, such as a lump sum directed to the lower priced animals of a particular species, or whatever criteria the supporter specifies.
- **Who can get Add-Ons?** Any youth exhibitor selling an animal through the 2026 auction. If an exhibitor did not make weight or was ineligible to sell, we cannot accept Add-Ons for them.
- **How do I do an Add-On?** The Add-On form can be found on our Facebook page and on our website. Instructions for submission are on the form. Add-Ons will be accepted until August 17, 2026 and payment must be remitted with the completed Add-On form.

Sale Order

- **Where and when will the Sale Order be posted?** We will post the Sale Order on our Facebook page and our website as soon as it is available on Friday, August 7th. Paper copies will be available at the Live Auction Event.
