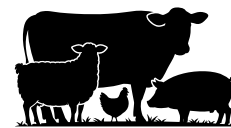

Optional Beef Weigh-In

Thursday, March 5th 3:30-6 PM

If your youth member would like to participate in the Rate of Gain Contest at the end of the year, they will need to weigh their steers on Thursday, March 5th, from 3:30–6:00 PM at the Crook County Fairgrounds. This is optional, but we will need to get an official weight on their steers to qualify for the contest. Also, wormer will be provided thanks to Central Oregon Ranch Supply!



FUN FACTS - DID YOU KNOW?

- Rabbits often purr. Happy rabbits purr when content and relaxed. The sound comes from teeth chattering softly.
- Rabbits eat their own poop. Though it may seem strange and gross, all healthy rabbits eat their own poop and digest it a second time. It is called “coprophagy” and is completely normal for rabbits.
- Rabbits have nearly 360 degree vision
- At the American Rabbit Breeders Association National Convention, there were close to 26,000 rabbits entered!
- The Guinness World Record holder, a Continental Giant named Darius, measured an incredible 4 feet 3 inches long and weighed nearly 50 pounds!

YQCA Certification

YQCA (Youth for the Quality Care of Animals) is required for ALL MEMBERS exhibiting animals at the County Fair.

Youth only exhibiting Horse and/or Small Animal (this includes dog) will have the option to take the YQCA certification training or one of the Alternative YQCA trainings.

Youth who completed YQCA training in 2025 are certified for three years and do not need to retake the training. However, if they are moving from a small animal; dog, horse, or static project to a large animal project (Beef, Swine, Goat, or Sheep), they will be required to complete the YQCA training online.

Once youth receive their certificate, they will need to email it to carmin.shelton@oregonstate.edu or provide a copy to the Crook County Extension Office. Youth that submitted their certifications last year, do not need to re-submit their certificate.

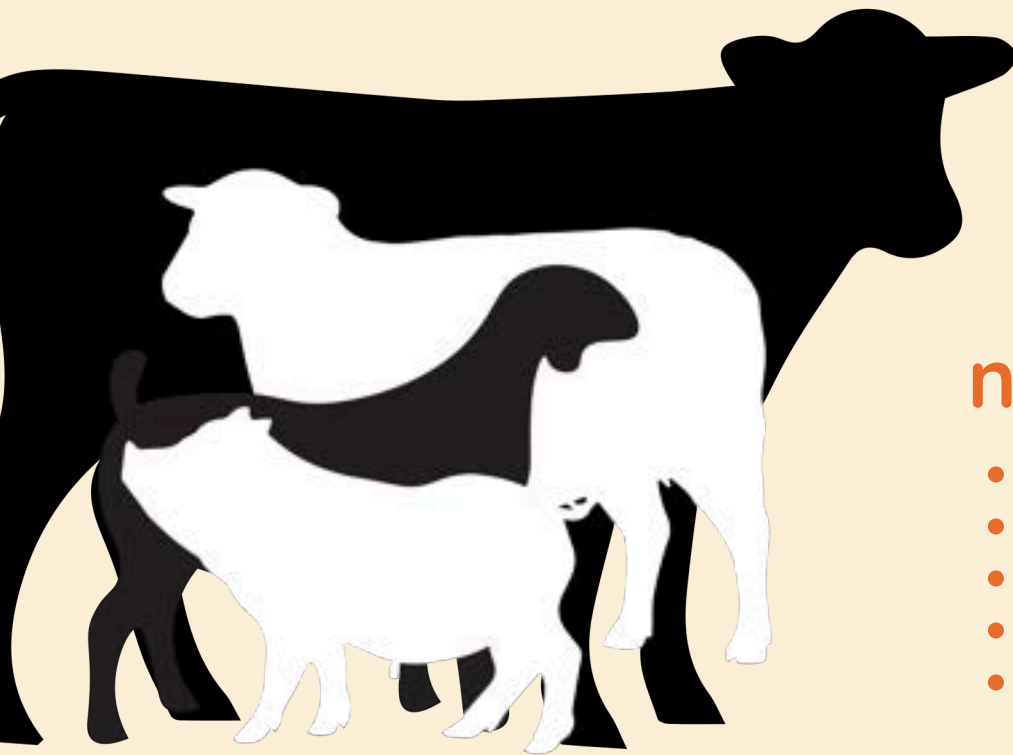
