**4-H ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS**

APPLICATION DEADLINE: JULY 15, 2026, by 5 P.M.

The Curry County 4-H Association Board has allocated funds to be awarded as scholarships to alumni of the 4-H program in Curry County. This scholarship is for alumni who have been out of high school for one or more years and are currently enrolled in a two-year or four-year college or university, technical or vocational school, and career driven continuing education programs.

Applicants must submit a completed application along with the required supplemental materials listed below on or before July 15, 2026, by 5 p.m. for full consideration. Interview of applicant (in person or Zoom) will be required.

ELIGIBILITY

- Be a former 4-H member in the Curry County 4-H program and exited the program in good standing.
- Be a student that has completed their first full year of college and obtained sophomore status (minimum 30 credits) or the equivalent in a technical or vocational school and currently enrolled in a post-secondary continuing education program in the 2026-27 school year.
- Submit application and supplemental documentation as requested on or before July 15, 2025, by 5 p.m.
- Complete interview with Curry County 4-H Scholarship Committee (TBD).

APPLICATION & SUPPLEMENTAL MATERIAL – Online & Paper Copy Available

- A completed **Application Form**.
- An up-to-date Professional Resume.
- A current copy of your unofficial college/vocational school transcript.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation. These letters should not be written by a family member.

All materials listed above must be included to complete your application.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Curry County 4-H Association Board has appointed members of the Board and community-at-large to serve on the 2025 Scholarship Committee. Applications will be weighted in favor of the length of 4-H involvement and service. The committee is looking for applications that articulate the area of interest or study being pursued and an expressed ability to succeed in the chosen area. Successful applicants will clearly demonstrate a commitment to the 4-H Mission.

Please review your application prior to submitting to ensure the short answer portion of your application displays the quality of writing appropriate for a student in post-secondary education. This includes mechanics such as spelling and grammar. Answers should demonstrate how your participation in 4-H has contributed to your personal growth and ability to actively contribute to your college and your community.

- Selected applicants will be required to participate in an interview (in person or Zoom). Interview schedule to be determined.
- Final selection will be made in October 2025.
- Selections will be notified via email.

DEADLINE:

Completed applications and supplemental material must be turned into the 4-H Office **on or before July 15, 2026, by 5PM**. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

PAYMENT

Payment will be made directly to the institute of study. Funds will be released in October. Recipient must provide a student identification number and the name and address where payment is to be sent to the 4-H Association Board treasurer. In the event that alternative arrangements must be made for payment, the 4-H Association Treasurer will work directly with the selected applicant. Payment cannot be made directly to the awardee.

* Eligible applicants will be considered for additional local/state 4-H Scholarships.
